Requirement: All food vendors must comply with City of Greater Geelong health regulations and provide relevant permits and insurance.

2. Arts, Crafts & Cultural Products

Traditional Arts: Calligraphy, Ikebana, Kimono/Yukata, Ceramic Artists.

Handicrafts: Handmade jewellery, unique Japanese textile goods, traditional toys.

Modern Products: Anime, Manga, J-Pop/K-Pop merchandise, unique homewares, and technological products.

3. Informational & Community Stalls

Japanese language schools, community associations, tourism information, and cultural demonstrations.
